In September of 2020 I joined Manoverboard Inc. and it was here that I provided front-end coding to websites with a focus on creating user-friendly products that are performant, accessible, and used best practices. It was in this team that I coded websites such as <u>The National Screen Institute of Canada</u>, and <u>Sierra Club Canada</u>. I have a passion for collaborating with my coworkers to create quality websites that will stand the test of time.

In early 2023 Manoverboard merged with Mangrove Web and I continued to do similar work there with the added responsibility of becoming a lead for Mangrove's Website Care. In this position I provided website maintenance updates and content modifications to clients, as well as developed processes and interacted daily with clients. I was a key part in teaching our clients how to use their products, and resolved any issues they had.

Over the summer of 2019 I was hired on by the Government of Manitoba through STEP services to methodically audit the internal website for Business Transformation and Technologies (BTT) and redesign it. Their original intranet site contained over five hundred pages and had been created in Microsoft Sharepoint. The hope was to create a new website in a modern CMS like WordPress. I worked with BTT policies, procedures and processes and through a manual content audit using Microsoft Excel, analysis in Microsoft Word, and redesign in Adobe Photoshop, I provided them with over five designs for the homepage and internal page templates.
