Web Developer

In 2024 I joined Marshal Yard, a marketing and communications company, as their web developer. This role focused on front-end development for new and legacy websites, as well as their hosting and maintenance. Scoping and quoting digital projects and leading internal accessibility initiatives was another important part of my job here. I developed websites such as the <u>Ecolabel Website</u>, and audited / remediated websites like for <u>DASCH</u> for WCAG accessibility.

Web Developer and Designer

I joined Manoverboard Inc. in 2020 and provided front-end coding with a focus on creating user-friendly products that are performant, accessible, and used best practices. It was in this team that I coded WordPress websites such as The National Screen Institute of Canada, and Sierra Club Canada, and Jamstack websites such as Re-Map and Inspiration Mobility. I have a passion for collaborating with my coworkers to create accessible websites that will stand the test of time.

Manoverboard merged with Mangrove Web in 2023 and I continued to do work there with the added responsibility of becoming a lead for Mangrove's Website Care. I led the website maintenance updates and content modifications for clients, as well as developed processes and interacted daily with clients. I was a key part in teaching our clients how to use their products, and resolved any issues they had.

Web Analyst STEP Position

Over the summer of 2019 I was hired on by the Government of Manitoba through STEP services to methodically audit the internal website for Business Transformation and Technologies (BTT) and redesign it. The aim was to create a new website in a modern CMS like WordPress. I worked with BTT policies, procedures and processes and created a content audit using Microsoft Excel, an analysis in Microsoft Word, and a redesign in Adobe Photoshop.
